






Low Income Energy Assistance Program

The Energy Assistance Program (EAP) helps pay for home heating costs and furnace repairs for income-qualified households.

EAP is federally funded through the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services.

Grants are:

- For renters or homeowners
 - For households with income at or below 50 percent of the state median income
 - Based on energy cost, household size, and income
 -  Apply
 -  Services
 -  2020 Maximum Energy Assistance Program Income Guidelines
- EAP eligibility is based on the three most recent months of income.
