AGREEMENT OF HUSBAND AND WIFE

- 1. We have made this agreement to establish, once and for all, that we owe each other no money or property and that we expect to receive no money or property each other in the future.
- 2. We will sign and exchange any documents that might be needed to complete this agreement before and after the divorce.
- 3. Husband and Wife own no real estate and we agree that we will not receive any real estate from each other in the future.
- 4. Each of us forever gives up any right to spousal maintenance (alimony) that we may have and the Red Lake Nation Tribal Court is divested of jurisdiction over spousal maintenance. This means we may never ask the Red Lake Nation Tribal Court to order spousal maintenance, even if our financial situations change in the future or the law on spousal maintenance changes in the future.

BASED UPON THE ABOVE INFORMATION, Husband and Wife request the Court issue a final judgement and decree terminating our marriage and ordering the terms of this agreement.
